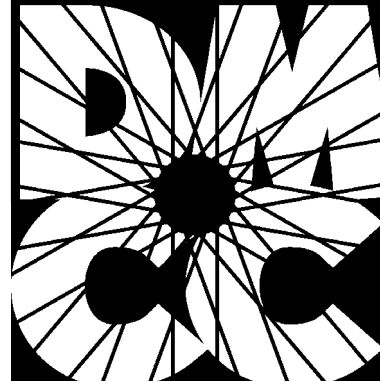

NEWS FROM THE RIDE RIGHT® SOFA

On January 18, 2004 the RIDE RIGHT Committee met to review the information gained from our visits with clubs and teams in October, your response to the RAGBRAI survey and a review of incident reports from last year's ride. The number one challenge for this year is the erratic rider. How do we get riders to be more predictable? The number one cause of injury on RAGBRAI for the past 5 years has been caused by cyclists striking other cyclists or swerving to avoid other cyclists.

TJ Juskiewicz, Assistant Director of RAGBRAI and Brian Martindale of Adventure Cycling, Inc. helped lead a discussion of how to best meet the challenge of the erratic or unpredictable cyclists. The discussion centered on clubs and teams working with new riders on riding in large groups. We will emphasize the need to participate in a large group ride or two so that you get the feel and an understanding of large group riding. Some clubs and teams will require riders participate in at least two group rides. RAGBRAI will help with links to other rides around Iowa and surrounding states. We will be reminding all readers of this column and the news letter to not only get training miles in, but, to get training miles riding in large groups.

We have found that riders are pretty good about signaling and calling out the first few days. We like to think our safety video reminds people of the need to signal. Unfortunately, the lessons learned seem to be forgotten about Wednesday. To help you remember to ride in lanes and to signal your intent to change lanes we will have lines drawn on the highway as a reminder to all that we must signal change in lanes.

We need everyone's help this year to make RAGBRAI safe and fun for all. You can help by encouraging others and being a role model for those you ride with. Signal and call out - We can't read your mind!!

Senate File 2032 - Send a letter today before the debate! We will help you write a letter! Make a difference for IOWA Cycling! (From www.bikeiowa.com)

Thanks for your interest in contacting your Iowa Legislator regarding this bill. We would like you to consider a few things before calling, writing or emailing.

We welcome those cyclists from out of state to contact Iowa Legislators too!!

The bill is not yet scheduled for debate. The Senate Majority Leader Stewart Iverson will decide if and when this bill will be debated. Contact Senator Iverson and let him know your concerns. His address is: Stewart.Iverson@legis.state.ia.us.

Hand-written notes are preferred for Senators or Representatives. Keep your remarks POSITIVE and not PERSONAL against Senator Putney. If you want to write your own note and not use the provided template, consider using these points in your correspondence:

- We APPRECIATE and USE Iowa's trails and WANT MORE.
- Support rider EDUCATION about common sense choices of what is the SAFEST route to ride your bicycle for HEALTH and RECREATION.
- Propose funding for bikeiowa.com and clubs for education

Email your remarks to every person you know, recommend drafting for local newspapers, and regional websites.

Dear Senator/Representative _____,

I write you today to oppose Senate File 2032, proposing removal of cyclists from four-lane roads where cycling trails lie adjacent.

I greatly appreciate Iowa's strong system of trails and roadways and the dedication to providing excellent opportunities for health, recreation and tourism.

As an active cyclist in the state of Iowa, I use cycling or multi-use trails ___# of times used___ annually, riding over ___mileage___ a year. I also ride on many public roadways as well, adhering to the rules of the road and bicycle safety.

Clearly, education is the short and long-term solution to Senate File 2032. Cyclists and motorists need continual education about safe choices when sharing the road. This includes public safety announcements, signage and training for cyclists and motorists.

The entire population of Iowa must be educated about bicycle safety, whether or not Senate File 2032 is passed. I would urge you to recommend education as the only course of action, instead of a law that would fine cyclists.

By providing resources to land managers, local bicycling clubs and statewide organizations, Iowa cyclists can be educated about the safest choices for riding bicycles, including helmets and routes, and improve use of bicycles for health, recreation and transportation.

Thank you for your consideration and support in this matter.

Des Moines Cycle Club RAGBRAI® XXXII Information

The Ragbrai® coordinators, Rich or Joni Siebenlist must receive your confirmation of registration printed from the new on line process located on the internet at www.ragbrai.org postmarked by February 23, 2004. Please send the confirmation, signed waiver, and check or money order payable to DMCC for all fees to 8784 - 95th Avenue, Indianola, IA 50125. All waivers must be signed and returned with your Ragbrai® confirmation.

Des Moines Cycle club members who apply through the club must not apply for additional Ragbrai® tags through the Register's lottery or through another club or organization. The Register checks for duplicate names and these individuals are completely eliminated from receipt of credentials.

If you have an email address, please indicate it so we can confirm receiving your application. We will send all correspondence by email. Tags will be distributed upon check-in at Charter Bus on July 24, 2004. If you are not traveling on the Charter Bus, you may request your tags be sent via mail. After May 1, 2004, you will be able to check the lottery results at www.ragbrai.org. You will need your unique ID # found on your confirmation page that you printed from the on line registration process.

Fees: You must purchase either a charter bus ride (\$110) or luggage service (\$65). Tent service option: If you choose this option, you will have a tent provided and set up for you each day. Each 3-person tent should be large enough for two people and their luggage. Cost is \$110 for the entire week of Ragbrai®. Funds generated from the tent option will be used to support the DMCC/DMOS/Mortgage Solutions Junior Race Team. Thank you for your support.

There will be NO REFUNDS after you have received notification of acceptance. The coordinators will keep a "wanted" and a "for sale" list, but will not be involved with the sale or transfer of credentials.

DMCC will provide charter bus and luggage transportation to any individuals who acquire their own Ragbrai® credentials. A DMCC membership is not required to use the club's charter bus or luggage transportation; however, DMCC membership is required to purchase Ragbrai® credentials through the club.

Bike boxes will be used as dividers between bicycles on the trucks. Each person is allowed only one bicycle. Tandem riders may bring only their tandem. Each rider is limited to two pieces of baggage (excluding your bicycle) with a maximum combined weight of 40 pounds. Each bag should not exceed 20 pounds. No suitcases, please. We strongly recommend some type of duffel bag. Additionally, no items should be attached/tied to the outside of your baggage.

Emergency sags: we have limited space available for individuals needing to sag for a day due to illness or injury. One of the truck drivers will be in charge of assigning seating in the event a rider needs to sag.

The Des Moines Cycle Club will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items. Please remember: You are responsible for ensuring that your baggage and cycling equipment are loaded on the proper vehicle during Ragbrai®.

On July 24, 2004, we will be loading the trucks and buses at the Clarion Hotel (formerly the Four Points Sheraton Hotel), located at 11040 Hickman Road (across from Living History Farms) in Des Moines. We have a block of rooms reserved for July 23 and July 31 until June 28, 2004. They have an airport shuttle. Indicate Des Moines Cycle Club for the rate of \$69 + tax when you make your reservation. Their phone number is 515-278-5575. For those participants that will be arriving via air transportation, we recommend arriving on July 23 and departing on August 1, 2004.

The Des Moines Cycle Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that all individuals participating in Ragbrai® XXXI wear approved bicycle helmets and follow the rules and laws that pertain to riding a bicycle on public roads. The Des Moines Cycle Club promotes safe cycling.

**AGREEMENT WAIVER &
RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

EACH APPLICANT MUST SIGN AN INDIVIDUAL WAIVER.

I, the undersigned, know that RAGBRAI is a potentially hazardous activity and I attend it out of my own free will and choice. In choosing to attend RAGBRAI and any related events, I fully accept and assume all risks, whether before, during or after RAGBRAI and its related events. These include, without limitation, physical injury, mental injury, emotional distress, trauma, sickness, illness, death, contact with other participants, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, the effects of weather including extreme temperature or conditions, traffic, contact with motor vehicles of all types and descriptions, collision with other riders or fixed objects, the conditions of the road, camping, and participating in events along the route. All risks are known and appreciated by me. I waive any and all specific notice of the existence of the risks. I shall assume and pay my own medical and emergency expenses in the event of injury, illness, or other incapacity regardless of whether I authorized such expenses.

I realize that RAGBRAI requires physical conditioning and I represent that I am in sound medical condition capable of participating in the ride without risk to myself or others. I have no medical impediment, which would endanger others or myself. I understand and agree that a situation may arise during RAGBRAI which may be beyond the control of the sponsors, promoters or organizers. I will be solely responsible for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle, safety gear and riding equipment. I will ride safely within the limits of my own abilities, my equipment and the riding conditions and in a manner so as not to endanger either myself or others.

Knowing these facts and in consideration of my entry acceptance, admission to and/or participation in RAGBRAI and its related events, I for myself and anyone acting on my behalf, release, waive, discharge, covenant not to sue and agree to hold The Des Moines Register and Tribune Company and its parent company, subsidiaries and affiliated entities; RAGBRAI sponsors and participating clubs, communities and organizations; RAGBRAI officials, emergency and support personnel, volunteers and their representatives; official Friends of RAGBRAI; and the officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents, and successors of all of the above, harmless from any and all claims, demands and actions of any and every kind I have, may have or may hereafter accrue

against the released parties directly or indirectly arising out of or relating in any respect to my attending or participating in RAGBRAI and its related events. My waiver and release of all claims, demands, actions and liability shall include without limitation, any injury, damage or loss to my person or property which may be (a) caused by any act, or failure to act, by the above-identified persons and entities or (b) sustained by me before, during or after RAGBRAI and its related events. I agree to abide by all RAGBRAI rules and regulations. I understand that my name, address, photograph, voice and/or likeness may be used in promotional or advertising materials of or by the Des Moines Register and Tribune Company, and its licensees. I consent to such uses and waive any rights of privacy or publicity I may have in connection with those uses. I further agree to indemnify and hold the parties released above harmless from any and all losses, damages, claims and expenses, including attorneys' fees, arising from or relating in any respect to my participation in RAGBRAI or its related events or my breach of this agreement. If I am a minor, my parent or guardian also is signing on my behalf and we both agree to be bound by the terms of this agreement, waiver and release.

I further agree and warrant that if at any time I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the activity.

2. FULLY understand that: (a) BICYCLING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, AND DEATH ("RISKS") (b) these risks and dangers may be caused by my actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SOCIAL AND ECONOMICAL LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

3.
